Les Limons de Chauffry

This hamlet in the Grand-Morin Valley is part of the town of Chauffry. In the early 19th century, Chauffry church was in danger of collapsing. It was demolished in 1847, and rebuilt near the rectory, to connect the town of Chauffry with the hamlet Les Limons.

The church was dedicated to the immaculate heart of Mary (hence its name) and blessed by the Bishop of Meaux the same year. In danger of falling to ruin again, it was demolished in 1986 and rebuilt on the site of the 13th-century church, and named after St-Sulpice.

In the early 20th century, the Société Nobel française (SNF) which manufactured celluloid dolls, set up shop in Chauffry. It provided jobs for the inhabitants of Chauffry, with 250 workers at the biggest of the five plants. It was still running in 1953, but has since closed.







Access: Paris Porte de Bercy, A4 for 33 km (exit 16), then D934 for 18 km to Coulommiers. From Coulommiers, Rebais is 12 km ENE on the D222. Line 77 Express N°1: Melun station-Coulommiers-Rebais station.

Practical information: all shops and restaurants. Positive elevation: 72m.

The Hiker's Code of Conduct

- Do not leave the marked paths.
- If there are any doubts regarding which path to take, markings take precedence over the description.
- Respect nature and private property.
- Don't litter.
- Avoid routes during hunting season (check with the town halls or the Seine-et-Marne hunting federation).
- Close gates and fences after you.
- Whenever possible, remove any obstacles from the path.


















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The hillsides above Le Raboireau

This second walk around Le Raboireau brook takes you along both sides of the valley, taking in several Rebais country hamlets along the way.

- 1 Leaving the church, take the steps to the path and turn left. Go down through the woods using the Bois-des-Fontaines path to the bridge over Le Raboireau brook.
- 2 Continue on the opposite bank. At the fork, turn left up to a road just outside the hamlet Les Potées. Go through the hamlet and continue along the road to reach the hamlet Les Limons.
- 3 Go straight over at the crossroads and at the tiny square, take the D61 on the left, past the washhouse. Follow the road for 400m then turn right into the path down towards Le Raboireau brook.
- 4 Cross over the brook and go up to the road. Cross the road and continue on the other side. At the fork, turn left to the hamlet La Brosse.
- **5** Continue along the road going through the hamlet Le Ménillot. At the second crossroads, turn right: the road becomes a path and you will come to a cross. Turn left to get back to the D61. Follow it on the right to Saint-Denis-lès-Rebais church.







The trail markings on this route are installed and maintained by 250 footpath wardens from the Seine-et-Marne departmental hiking committee. (Codérando 77). It is part of a network of 4,500 km of walking and hiking trails in the department.
