# Pil cuman – Welcome

A UNESCO World Heritage Site since December 2001, Provins is one of the best-preserved medieval towns in France. Every street corner reflects the splendour of the former capital of the Counts of Champagne.

The love affair between Héloïse and Abélard, the passion between Blanche of Castille and Thibaud le Chansonnier, and the Count of Champagne who brought the Damask rose back from the Crusades still haunt the streets of Provins.

In the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> centuries, the Provins Fairs were the most important in Europe. The city welcomed cloth merchants from Flanders, Lombard financiers, spice merchants from the East, and more.

But in the 14<sup>th</sup> century, changes in trade routes, wars, epidemics, and the annexation of the lands of Brie and Champagne to the Kingdom of France led to the city's decline.

In the 19<sup>th</sup> century, writers such as Honoré de Balzac and Jules Verne and painters such as Moreau le Jeune came to enjoy the romantic view of the ruins of the ramparts and the ivy-covered César Tower.

Today, Provins is a wonderfully preserved medieval town with 58 monuments listed or registered in the Inventory of Historic Monuments.

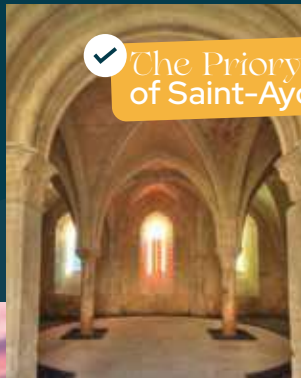

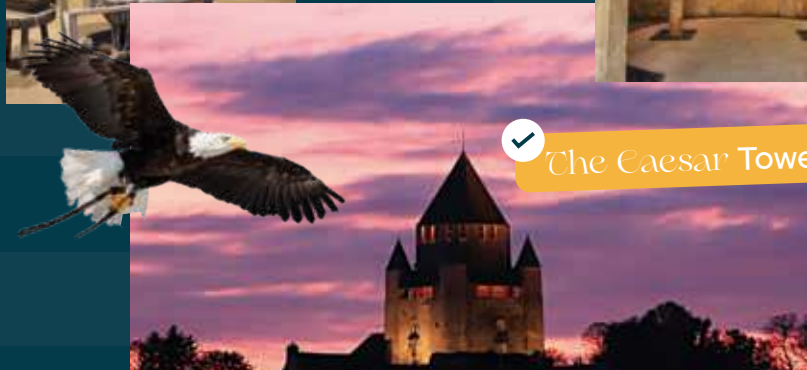

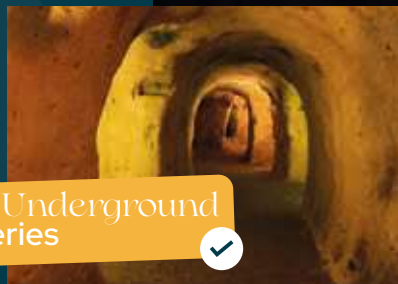

### The Caesar Tower

Climb to the top of this imposing 12<sup>th</sup>-century keep. Once a symbol of the power of the Counts of Champagne, it served as a watchtower, prison and bell tower. The top floor offers breathtaking panoramic views of the entire medieval city!

### The Tithe Barn

Step back in time and explore the magnificent vaulted rooms of this former merchant's house, typical of Provins. Immerse yourself in the lively atmosphere of the Champagne Fairs with an audio-guided tour and scenography based on medieval trades.

### The Priory of Saint-Ayoul

Included in the PASS



Built in 996, after the discovery of the relics of Saint-Ayoul, the priory became a major pilgrimage site and the birthplace of the Champagne Fairs, where merchants, travellers and pilgrims from all over Europe gathered.

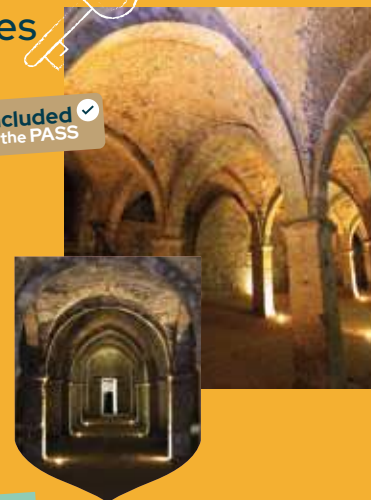

### The Provins and the Provins area Museum

Visit one of the oldest buildings in Provins! Housed in the Romanesque house, this Museum of France contains treasures from antiquity to the 19<sup>th</sup> century: gold and silverware, sculptures, paintings and rare objects such as a potter's wheel.

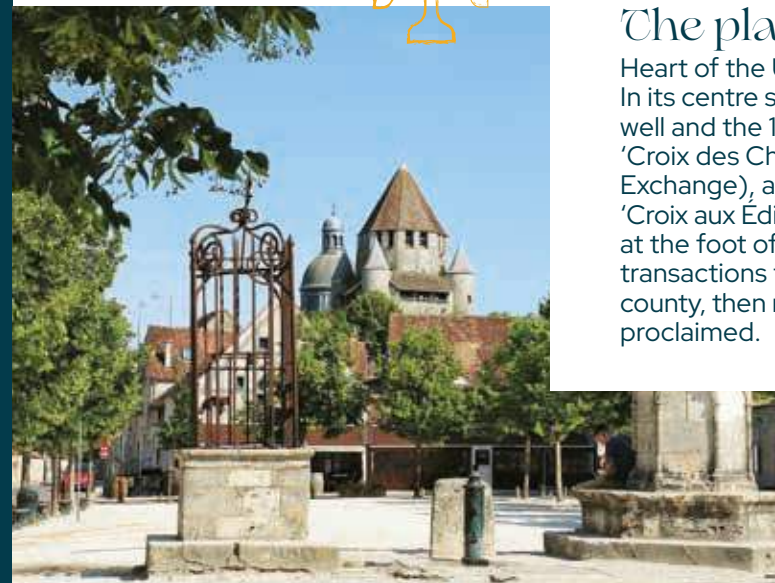
## The ramparts and gates

Built between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> centuries, they are 25 metres high and once stretched for 5 kilometres. Today, 1.2 kilometres remain around the Upper Town. The Saint-Jean gate, with its two almond-shaped towers, defended the old Paris Road. The Jouy gate, built in the 13<sup>th</sup> century, was topped by a bell tower, a small keep with a bell, which was used to watch for enemies and warn of danger.



## The place du Châtel

Heart of the Upper Town: In its centre stands an ancient well and the 13<sup>th</sup>-century 'Croix des Changes' (Cross of Exchange), also known as the 'Croix aux Édits' (Cross of Edicts), at the foot of which currency transactions took place and county, then royal, edicts were proclaimed.



## The Half-timbered houses

As you stroll through the streets of Provins, look up at these typical medieval houses with facades from another era. You can see them all over the town!



## The Sainte-Croix Church

Built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century on the site of a pre-existing chapel, this church owes its current name to a piece of Christ's Cross that is said to have been brought back from the Holy Land by Thibaud IV, son-in-law of Saint Louis.

• Open every weekend from 28 March to 1<sup>st</sup> November.



## The Saint-Quiriace Collegiate church

Built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century by Count Henry the Liberal, its construction was interrupted by the kingdom's financial difficulties, yet it still stands today as a testament to the ambition of the Counts of Champagne. On the forecourt, a simple cross marks the location of the planned entrance, which was never completed.



## The Garnier Gardens

This garden and the majestic villa are named after Victor Garnier, a wealthy benefactor who bequeathed his property to the city in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.



## The boulevard d'Aligre - jardin des promenades

This boulevard, much loved by the people of Provins, follows the old route of the ramparts, which have now disappeared, although a few remains can still be seen. Bordered by the Fausse Rivière, it offers a pleasant stroll punctuated by superb views of the medieval town and a magnificent garden at the foot of the station: the Jardin des Promenades Provinoises.

## The Saint-Ayoul Church

The historic birthplace of Provins and its trade fairs, the church square once welcomed merchants and pilgrims.

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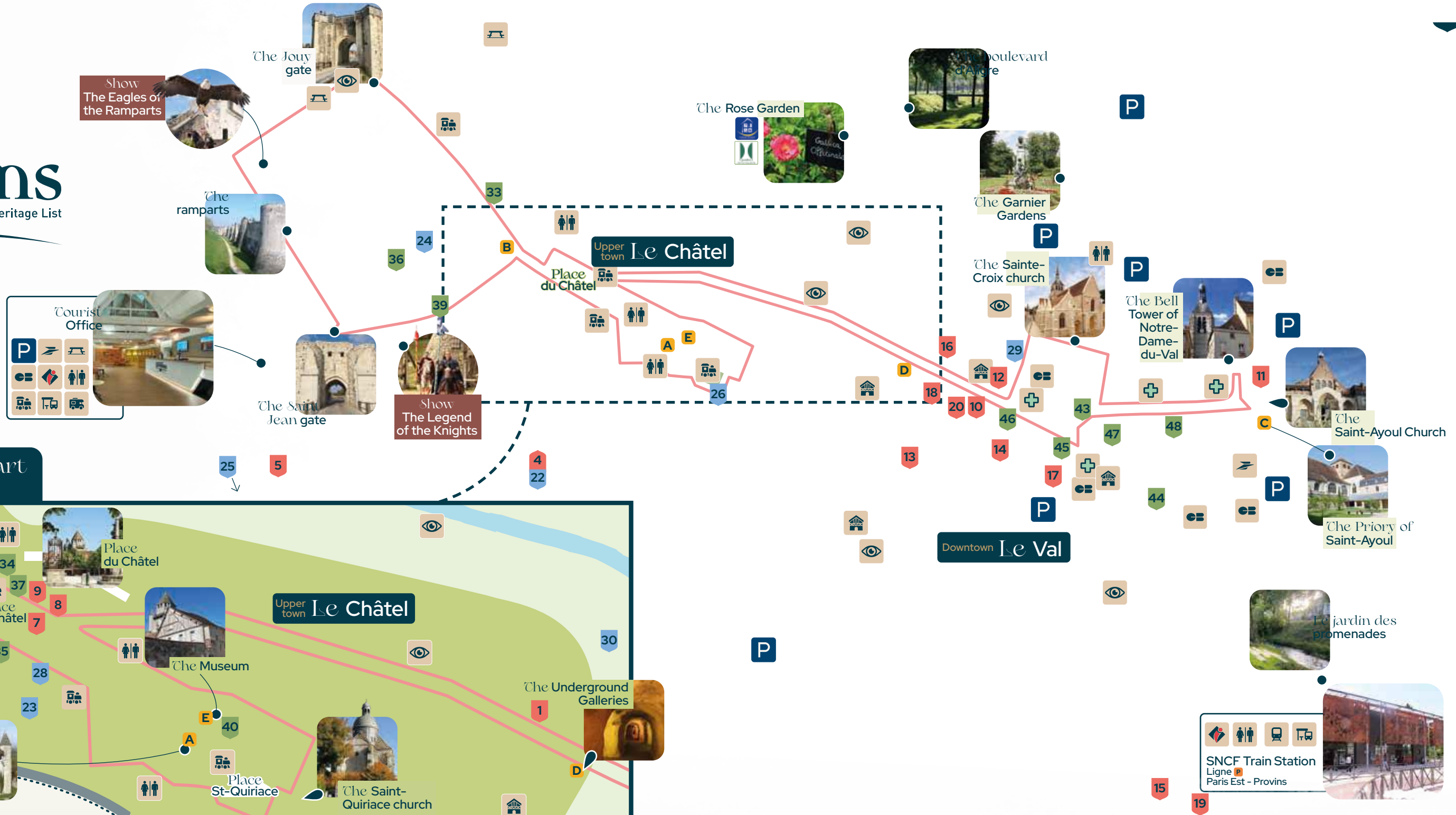

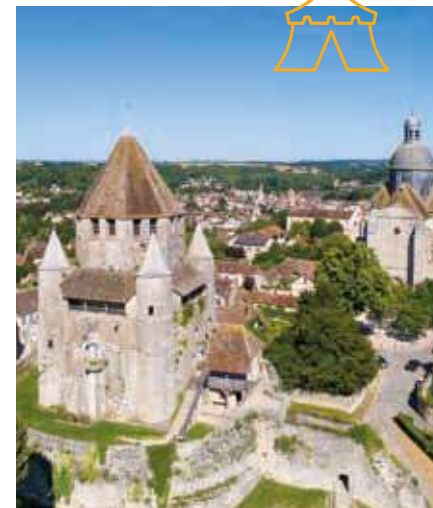

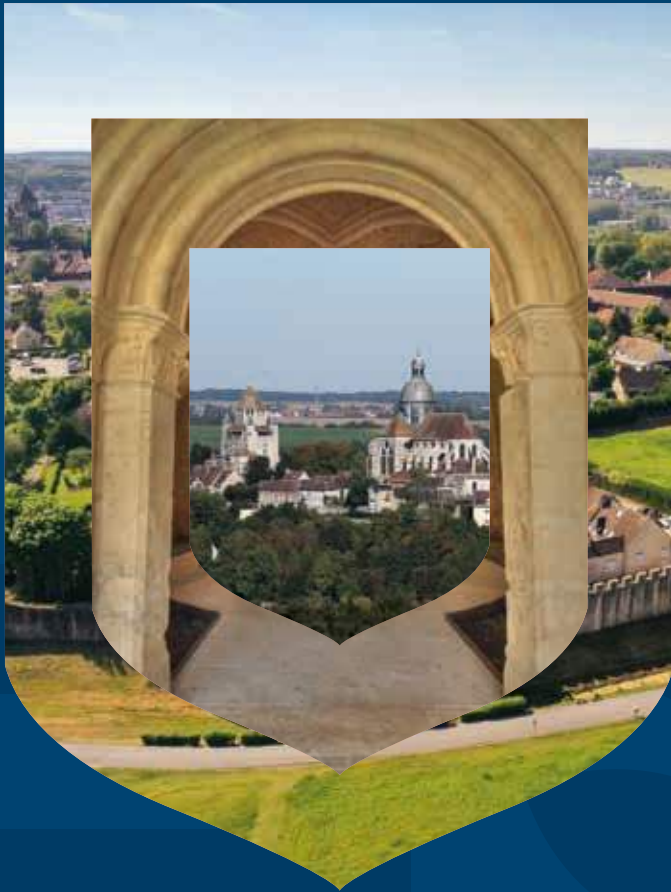
